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## **Psychiatry Working Group 2020 Recap**

#### 1. <u>Psychiatry Vocabulary</u>

- a) Represent Psychiatry Scale Codes
- b) Collaborate with SNOMED to incorporate and represent Scale Codes

#### 2. Adoption & Community Contribution

- a) AJOU, SMINDU, UHK, University de Lille, Akrivia contributed to the Scale Codes
- b) Involvement with the N3C NLP group to understand patterns in the scale data extraction process

#### 3. Network Studies

- a) External validation of model predicting Bipolar Misdiagnosed as MDD
- b) Validate machine learning model predicting newly diagnosed MDD patients within 1 year after initiation of beta-blocker for cardiovascular disease



## **Overall Goals for 2021**

- 1. To address the different challenges of data harmonization across areas of Psychiatry
- 2. To better understand the Vocabularies used across the specialty
- 3. To decide what is necessary to move current data into the OMOP model
- 4. To help each other understand and learn from experiences
- 5. Collaboration and assimilation with other industry groups



### Plan to Achieve The Goals

- 1. Continued enhancement of the Psychiatry Vocabulary
  - Hierarchical representation of the Scale Vocabulary
  - Funding of the continues Vocabulary development efforts through grant opportunities
- 2. Exploration and adoption of the Rdocs Framework
  - RDoc is a widely used framework for connecting neurological and genetic causes of disease
  - It would be useful to have a hierarchy that either adopting or relating to it in some way
- 3. Continued participation in Network Studies
  - OHDSI/UHK/IQVIA study to access the impacts of COVID-19 on people with mental health conditions
- 4. Exploration of N3C NLP efforts to extract Psychiatry Codes from unstructured data sources
