





Atlas



- "De-identified" OMOP
- Refreshed 1-2 times a year
- Access to 15K users via clinical system
 - "Can I have this for my patient list"
- Use it to collaborate with clinical researchers
 - "Data consultation" ~10/yr
 - Improves our data
- Another version for DBMI

- Security is managed centrally through AD server
- Generally two minor version behind current Atlas version



What is OMOP?

The Observational Medical Outcomes Partnership (OMOP) CDM, offers a solution unlike any other. OMOP found that disparate coding sy standardized vocabulary. Once a database has been converted to the OMOP CDM, evidence can be generated using standardized analyt for data quality and characterization, medical product safety surveillance, comparative effectiveness, quality of care, and patient-level pr some of them commercial. Below is the specification of the OMOP CDM 5.1.1.





Leveraging OMOP




- Support research data requests

 - US News Report
 - Half the time (4 vs 8 weeks)
 - Reusable code
