Ongoing Work

- Facilitate involvement, visibility, and networking opportunities for ESR
 - Develop a Mentor and Membership Directory for matchmaking
 - Create onboarding roadmap for trainees in different disciplines and career paths (Informatics, Epidemiology, Medicine, Statistics, etc.)



Ongoing Work

- Expand the group leadership structure and better support global participation
 - Recruit dedicated members to organize monthly series, mentor/mentee directory, and outreach
 - Identify representatives to liaise with regional chapters
 - Expand ESR WG membership to include active members from at least three regional chapters.

Grow OHDSI network and ESR WG membership

- Develop ESR WG promotional materials
- Advertise OHDSI and ESR WG to institutions and organizations that have not previously participated in OHDSI
- Distribute OHDSI and ESR promotional materials at non-OHDSI scientific fora, in particular, those that cater to ESRs
